QUADRANT PRESCRIPTION: CIRCLE YOURS

Q1 Protect what works. Do not add process to a healthy loop.

Q2 Invest in the augmentation layer, with anti-overreliance discipline attached.

Q3 Fix the measurement pathway. Re-route, do not re-build.

Q4 Distinguish pathology from deliberate posture before prescribing anything.

COUPLING CHECK

Does this constraint share a decision node with another chain? If yes, target the shared node; the coupling resolves itself.

Do several chains depend on an operating-model property the organisation lacks? If yes, per-chain fixes will not hold; intervene at that layer.
